

Instructions for authors of collective monograph (Volume 3) «HUMAN HEALTH: REALITIES AND PROSPECTS».

1. All margins are 20 mm.
2. The text is prepared by Microsoft Word : the page is A4; the book orientation; the single interval; the font Times New Roman, size 12. The paper of 10 to 15 pages (not less than 20000 characters) to review articles - 15-20 pages.
3. Paragraph - 1.2 mm
4. Numbering pages - only by pencil in the top right corner of the page (electronic version of the article pages are **not numbered!**).
5. Tables, graphs, drawings, photographs, diagrams should be named, numbered and presented in the text of the article with links to them. The format illustrations should not exceed A4 size. Formula should be performed using the formula editor.
6. References up by alphabetical order (they denote numbers in square brackets) and served in the end. The sources of literature should give the names of all authors cited articles without cutting their list, the full title of the article, commonly accepted abbreviated name of the journal, volume, number and pages. Titles of books (monographs, collected works), theses, abstracts and patents, etc. should be given in full. You can not rely on unpublished materials.

The authors are solely responsible for the correctness of these links.

References should be presented in two separate blocks:

Block 1 (Literature) - References in the original language.

Block 2 (References) - the same references, but in English. The names of authors, titles of journals cited according to one of the international system of transliteration. Titles of articles in references should be submitted in English translation. Links to foreign publications fully repeated in the list, quoted in Latin.

The order for placing the material:

Title of the article (in English)

The initials and surname(s)
of author(s) - in English
The full name of the
institution
and its address, country
E-mail

Title of the article (in Ukrainian)

Summary (in English: name (s) , title(s) of article(s) , text, summary, from 1000 to 1500 characters with spaces).

Keywords (10 words).

Text

Summary

References

For experimental articles provided the following sections:

Summary in English (from 1,000 to 1,500 characters with spaces), keywords (10 words).
Introduction, materials and methods of research, results and discussion, conclusions, literature.

Instructions to authors

All symbols and letters of the Greek and other alphabets must clearly print the appropriate signs or write by hand.

Images and text tables should be numbered in Arabic numerals, in the order of first mention reduced to: Figure 1, Table. 1, etc. If a picture or a table, the text states: table drawing. References served in brackets by the numbers in the reference list - [].

In case of non-observance of these requirements the manuscript will not be accepted for review. Articles that are not relevant to the collective monograph rejected.

Registration fee

The registration fee is 40 UAH per page (for foreign participants - 3 € per page).
